



Training Course:

CONFINED SPACE VESSEL ENTRY

This two day course provides personnel with a thorough understanding of the potential hazards and management controls required to carry out work in confined spaces safely.

The course combines classroom-based and practical learning, although the emphasis is on practical demonstrations and exercises using a purpose-built confined space training module. Exercises will include the use of self-contained breathing apparatus, winches and rescue equipment. The syllabus focuses on:

- Legislation and Regulations
- Safe Systems of Work
- Management Responsibilities
- Atmospheric Monitoring and the Detection of Gases
- Properties of Gases
- Entry and Access Requirements
- Safety Equipment
- Personnel Responsibilities
- Use of Breathing Apparatus
- Emergency Planning and Procedures

The course will include a written assessment to ensure delegates have a clear understanding of the requirements.
